PETER EISEN SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Description: The goal of the Peter Eisen Scholarship is to honor the legacy and contributions of Peter Eisen during his lifetime and assist a college bound high school senior or current college student who has experienced the loss of a biological parent before the age of 18. This scholarship is based on merit and demonstrated financial need.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Student has experienced the loss of a biological parent before the age of 18.
- Student has been accepted into an accredited college/university within the United States.
- Student will be enrolled on a full time basis (12 credits per semester).
- Student will have achieved a 3.0 or better cumulative GPA.
- Student must have demonstrated need.
- Preference will be given to Essex, Middlesex or Bergen County residents.

Scholarship Selection: Applicants will be evaluated based on several factors including but not limited to academic performance, leadership, extra-curricular activities, work experience (whether paid or unpaid), financial need and references. Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Foundation's Board of Trustees based upon the recommendation of its respective Scholarship Committee.

Terms of Scholarship Award: The Peter Eisen Scholarship will offer one or more scholarships annually. Award amount will vary dependent upon the student's demonstrated need. The amount of the award will be applied equally between the academic year fall and spring semesters. It is important to note that a copy of the student's school tuition bill and a final financial aid statement will be required prior to release of any award.

The scholarship award will be paid directly to the educational institution for credit to the student's account and may be used to offset educational expenses such as tuition, on campus room and board and other mandatory educational fees.
